- An Annual Title I public meeting will be held at the beginning of the school year in the month of **September** at **Greenwood Middle School** to discuss our school wide project, new federal regulations, and requirements as it relates to our Title I program and parents' rights to be involved. A Virtual meeting option will be held in the event of a Pandemic.
- A Learning Compact that outlines how parents, school staff, and students will share the responsibility for improved students' achievement will be sent home in **October** of each school year for parents to utilize to support their child at home.
