Dear Parent/Guardian:

North Carolina General Statute requires a completed North Carolina Health Assessment Transmittal Form for every student entering NC Public Schools for the first time. No student new to North Carolina Public Schools may attend without presenting the completed North Carolina Health Assessment Transmittal Form to the school principal. The physical examination must have been within 12 months before the first day of school.

This letter serves as notice that you have 30 calendar days to bring the completed North Carolina Health Assessment Transmittal Form to the principal. At the end of 30 days, after _____, your child will not be permitted to attend school until the North Carolina Health Assessment Transmittal Form is provided. (N.C.G.S. Chapter 130A-440, 441, 442)

If your child had a physical exam since _____, please ask your child's primary medical health care provider to fill out the North Carolina Health Assessment Transmittal Form. Wayne County Health Department and other local medical providers may have appointments available if you are not able to obtain an appointment before the suspension date. Please ask your school nurse for more information.

Please note that having an appointment does not allow the principal to re-admit your child to school. The actual North Carolina Health Assessment Transmittal Form must be completed and returned to school by the deadline.
