*Continuous Subcutaneous Insulin Infusion (Insulin Pump)*

For all students using insulin pumps:

1. Parent will provide complete supplies for set changes, insulin, and syringes or insulin pen and cartridges, and batteries to be maintained in the office or health office.
2. Parent agrees school is not responsible to replace pumps that are lost, damaged, or stolen at school.

\_\_\_\_\_ Student is responsible for maintaining his/her insulin pump.

This student has been trained to independently manage his/her pump. This student can interpret blood glucose levels and take appropriate action for the results including, but not limited to:

1. Changing of pump infusion sets, infusion site, tubing, and batteries.
2. Determining and giving boluses of insulin to correct elevated blood sugars above target range and for food eaten.
3. Changing to injections by syringe or pen, should there be a problem with the functioning of the pump.

\_\_\_\_\_ Student is not able to independently maintain his/her insulin pump.

Because of the young age or lack of developmental readiness, this student cannot independently manage his/her pump.

1. Parent will provide the school nurse and/or other school personnel with training in how to suspend or stop the pump in the event of an emergency.
2. Call parent with pre-lunch blood glucose so parent can instruct staff on insulin dose if directed by plan.
3. School personnel will need to verify the dose in pump before child pushes the activation button.
4. Parent must be called at any time according to the plan.
5. If a student is unresponsive and the blood sugar is low, the pump can be removed so no insulin is infusing.
6. The student will report pump alarms/malfunctions to school personnel, who will call the parent for problem solving.
7. The student will report site tenderness to school personnel, who will call the parent for problem solving.
8. If the school/parents are agreeable for the school to assume more responsibility for the pump operation, this can be negotiated between the two.
9. In case of pump malfunction, the parent will come to the school within 30 minutes to remedy the situation.
