One school did not have enough qualified applicants; and one applicant from this school declined. Those two slots were allocated to the two schools with the highest percentage of 8th graders to maintain equitable distribution across the district.

As required by Wayne Early Middle College High School's founding principles, 80% of students selected are 1st generation college, equitably distributed across district feeder patterns.

Of 137 total 8th grade applications, 31 did not meet the criteria for admission and were disqualified from the lottery. Qualifications are:

- 1. Student can be no more than two years below grade level.**
- 2. Student has no serious discipline infractions.**
- 3. Student has no significant attendance issues.**
