**In addition to the seats allotted for rising sixth grade students, 4 additional seats have also been allocated in 2020-21 for qualified military-connected students whose families PCS into Wayne County after the spring 2020 application and lottery occurred. For more information about these seats, military families should contact Christy Barnes, SJAFB School Liaison Officer.

One school did not have enough qualified applicants, those two slots were allotted to the two schools with the highest percentages of 5th graders to maintain equitable distribution across the district.

Of 170 total 5th grade applications, 17 did not meet the criteria for admission and were disqualified from the lottery. Qualifications are:

- 1. Student can be no more than two years below grade level.**
- 2. Student has no serious discipline infractions.**
- 3. Student has no significant attendance issues.**
